NEW PROJECTS

The CoC received three new project applications, including a Domestic Violence Bonus application, totaling \$735,352.00 in funding. The CoC had a total of \$4,816,120.00 in funding to award. This amount includes funding from the following sources: The Annual Renewal Demand for existing programs, Permanent Housing Bonus, voluntary reallocation, CoC Planning grant. Additionally, the CoC was allowed to apply for \$415,450.00 in Domestic Violence Bonus funding as part of the 2018 HUD NOFA competition
