NEW PROJECTS

The CoC had a total of \$719,453 in funding to award. This amount includes funding from the following sources: the CoC Bonus (\$227,820.00), the DV Bonus (\$425,133), and money recaptured through the partial reallocation of projects with underspending (\$66,500).

The CoC received two new project applications totaling \$211,435.00. Both projects were accepted and will be included and ranked on the Project Priority List. No new project applications were rejected. The new projects:
